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EXPANDING SUPPORT FOR LOCAL STUDENTS THROUGH SUMMER LEARNING

Winterville, NC, July 11, 2024: Horizons of Pitt County has teamed up with Pitt Community College (PCC) to offer summer learning opportunities to local youths.

A member of Horizons National, Horizons of Pitt County supports the academic achievement and healthy youth development of selected Pitt County Schools elementary and middle school students. This summer, the program is utilizing PCC facilities to offer participants five weeks of enriching activities focused on learning, building confidence, and fostering joy.

Research shows that students who lack enriching summer activities can lose up to two months of their reading and math skills. In contrast, Horizons students consistently gain 6-10 weeks of skills in these subjects over each summer session. Year after year, more than 70% of Horizons students return to participate, and nationally, 97% of Horizons high school students graduate on-time, highlighting the program's impact.

Horizons' approach emphasizes hands-on, project-based learning that cultivates a passion for education. This approach integrates science, art, reading, math, field trips, swimming, and other enrichment experiences. In cooperation with PCC, Horizons of Pitt County aims to prepare students to go from crayons to college.

Horizons of Pitt County Board Chair, Dr. Virginia Hardy, states, "The Horizons program is thrilled to celebrate its 10th summer in Pitt County providing a customized curriculum and enrichment to nurture the development of our Scholars. None of this would be achievable without the generous support from our community and corporate partners."
